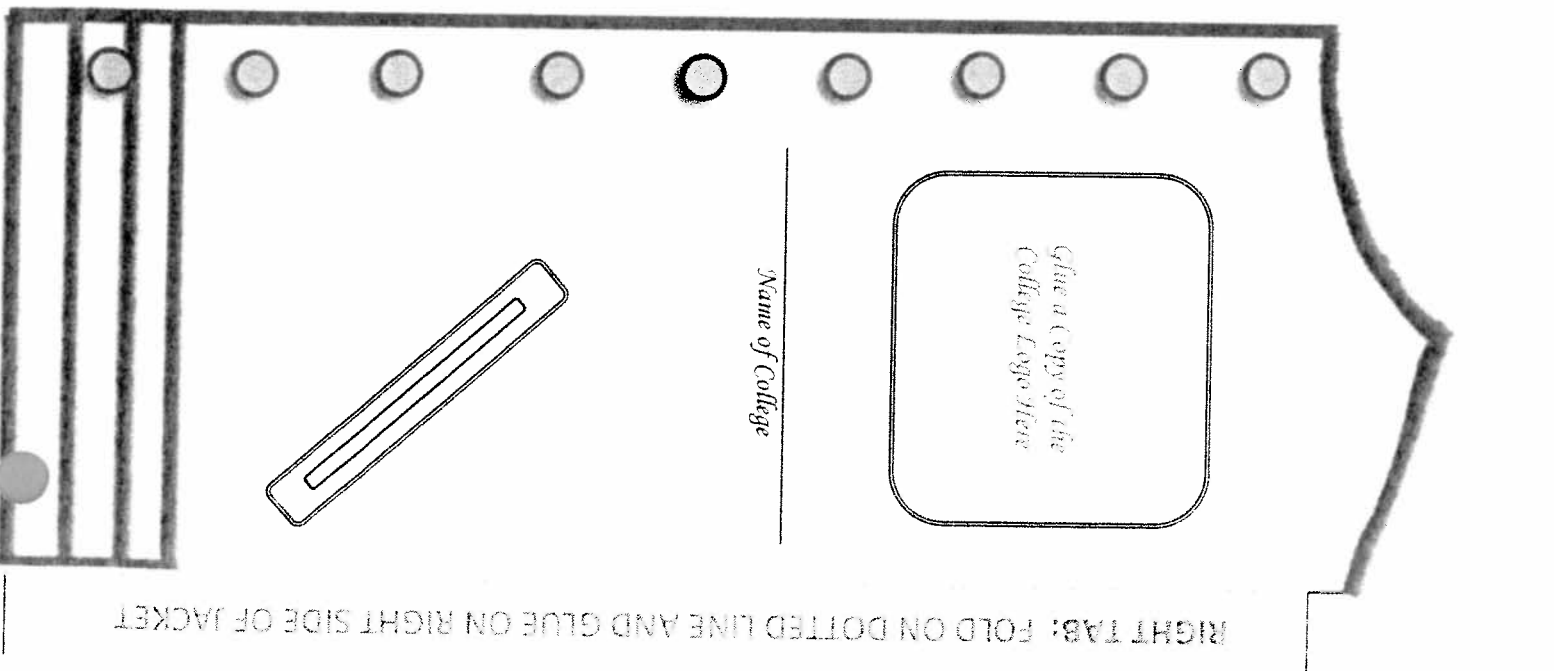
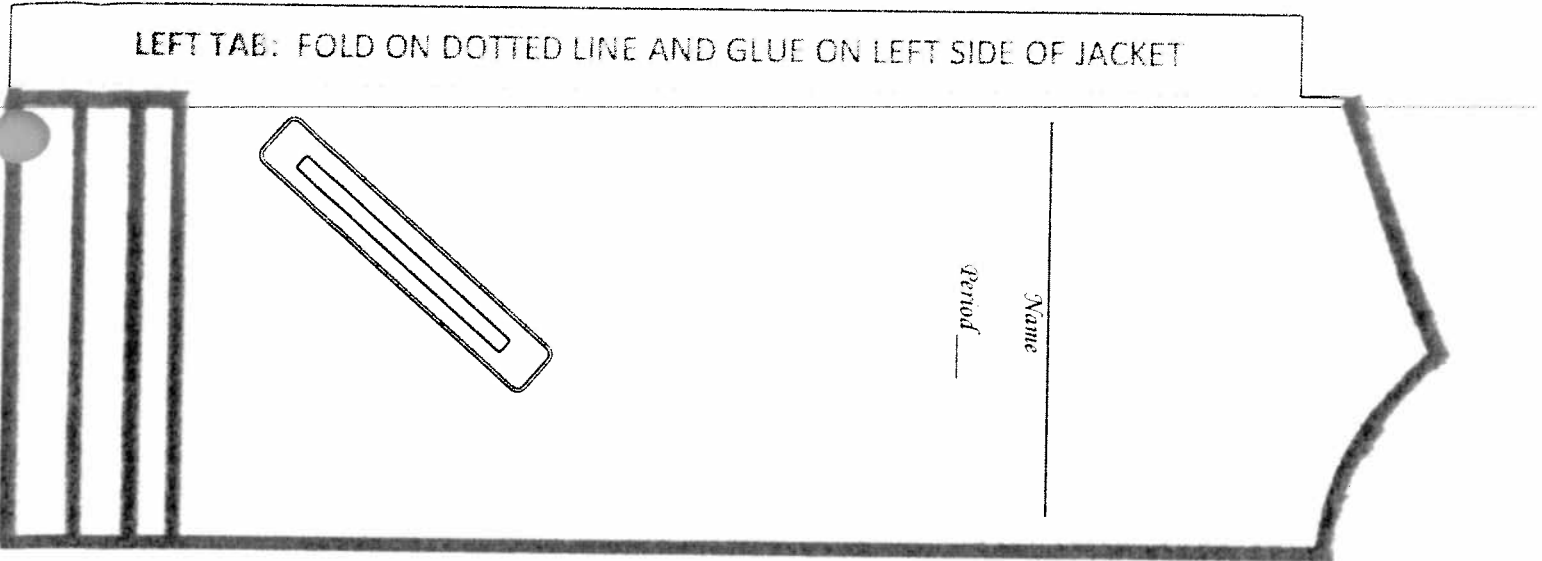
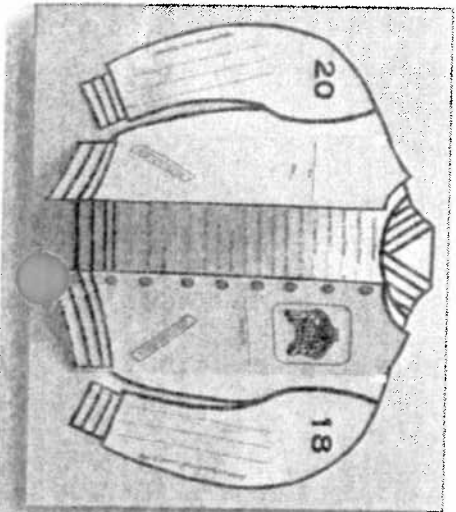


College Research Jacket
