
Literacy tests were used to keep people of color -- and sometimes poor whites --from voting.

They were administered at the discretion of the officials in charge of voter registration and if
the official wanted a person to pass, he could ask the easiest question on the test – for
example, "Who is the president of the United States?" The same official might require a black
person to answer every single question correctly, in an unrealistic amount of time, in order to pass.

The following test is examples of questions given to citizens in Alabama and Louisiana to prove they were of 5<sup>th</sup> grade education level. Do what you are asked, nothing more, and nothing less. Be careful as one wrong answer denotes failure of the test. You have 10 minutes to complete the test. Are you smarter than a 5<sup>th</sup> grader?
