

AVID Mock College Application

To complete your AVID Mock College Application Project, you must:

1. Applications and all supplemental materials will be due Friday, December 11th to your AVID teacher. No late applications will be accepted and all materials must be present. This will be an online portfolio. Information on this will be forthcoming.
2. Applications and all supplemental materials will be reviewed during second semester by a panel of staff members.
3. Admissions letters will be mailed out by the end of January and should be received in early February.
4. **ALL ASSIGNMENTS MUST BE TURNED IN ON TIME IN ORDER TO BE GRADED. THIS MEANS NO LATE ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED!**

1. **College Interest Survey (Complete August 25th)** - *All students will complete a college interest list by using College Raptor. Write down 10 colleges you would be interested in applying to. Please submit your list to Canvas by August 26th. The list of the four colleges you are applying to needs to be determined by December 7th.*
2. **College Jackets (Submitted to Canvas on September 2nd)** - *Based on the 10 colleges you selected, you will pick 3 of those colleges to complete a college jacket on. This will give you an opportunity to learn more about the colleges you selected.*
3. **College Research Paper (Rough Draft Due submitted to Canvas on September 23rd; Final Draft submitted to Canvas on November 6th)** - *All students will submit a college research paper. The paper must be typed, double-spaced and no more than 3 pages in length.*
4. **College Commercial (Submitted to Canvas on November 20th)** - *In groups of no more than 4, students will create a 30 second to 1-minute video advertising one university. This video will need to highlight and sell the campus. This video will be placed on daily announcements and/or TitanTV.*
5. **Brag Sheet (Completed on September 30th)** - *All students will need to complete a brag sheet and make 3 photocopies (to give to people writing their letter of recommendation). Students will also need to maintain a digital copy of their brag sheet for future purposes.*
6. **Letters of Recommendation (Submitted to Canvas on November 13th)** - *All students will need to have 2 letters of recommendation from teachers or staff members on campus. Cannot use Miss Toller, Mr. Evans or Mrs. Strange.*
7. **College Application (Submitted to Canvas on December 11th)** - *All students will need the mock college application filled out by the day of the application deadline. Information must be accurate, legible, and complete in order to be reviewed by admissions.*

- 8. Personal Statement/Insight Questions (Rough Draft submitted to Canvas on November 20th; Final draft with application on December 11th) - *All students will type responses to any 2 of the given 4 prompts of the insight questions provided.***

- 9. Official/Unofficial Copies of Transcripts (Meet with Ms. Espinoza to Review Transcripts during the week of September 14th-September 18th via Zoom)**
