# Notebook Checks

- Classwork will continue to be turned in via Notebook Checks on Canvas. Remember, they **MUST** be submitted as a single PDF.
  - I posted the directions for how to submit the notebook check as a PDF under Friday of this week, however, if you would like a hard copy, let me know.
- I will be doing random notebook checks this semester.
  - Our first one will be on Monday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - If your notebook is not put together, I will not grade further notebook checks until you show me that your notebook has been fixed.
- In order to earn full points on your notes, you **MUST** interact with them.
  - You can review how to interact with your notes under our 'Class Information' tab in Canvas.

# Absences

- In the event that you are absent, you **MUST** check Canvas to see what you missed.
  - Please look at the 'Content of the Week...' for what you missed that week.
  - I have each day laid out so if you know you're going to miss say Thursday of this week, just scroll down to Thursday.
- Asking me what we did yesterday is not an appropriate question.

  - Clarification questions on assignments are fine.
- When absent, if there is an assignment that needs to be stamped, you have an equal amount of days to get it stamped. If not, it is half credit.
